An opportunity to look at languages progression in primary schools in relation to the forthcoming revised OFSTED framework. The workshop seeks to share assessment frameworks and children's writing to understand the progression in the languages curriculum and how to prepare for transition to secondary school.

Outline for the workshop includes:

- Assessment frameworks: How do we assess across the four skills? What do languages teachers use in school? What assessment frameworks exist?
- -Sharing assessment frameworks: Coordinators and attendees to bring assessment documents they use.
- -What does progression look like in the classroom? Learning walk at Rise Park to look at how progression can look across phases in primaries and sharing of ideas for building progression.
- Examples of writing in languages: Attendees to bring two pieces of work from Year 3 and Year 6 to link to curriculum objectives and share ideas for teaching a range of objectives across KS2. Looking at KS3 writing to see what children are working towards.
