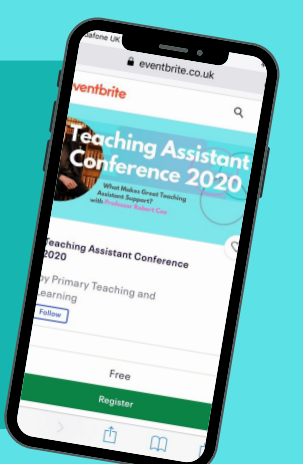

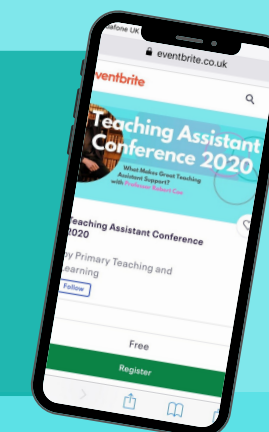


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## What to expect from **the day**

Futures for Business will also be running a stall offering advice on training and qualification opportunities for Teaching Assistants.

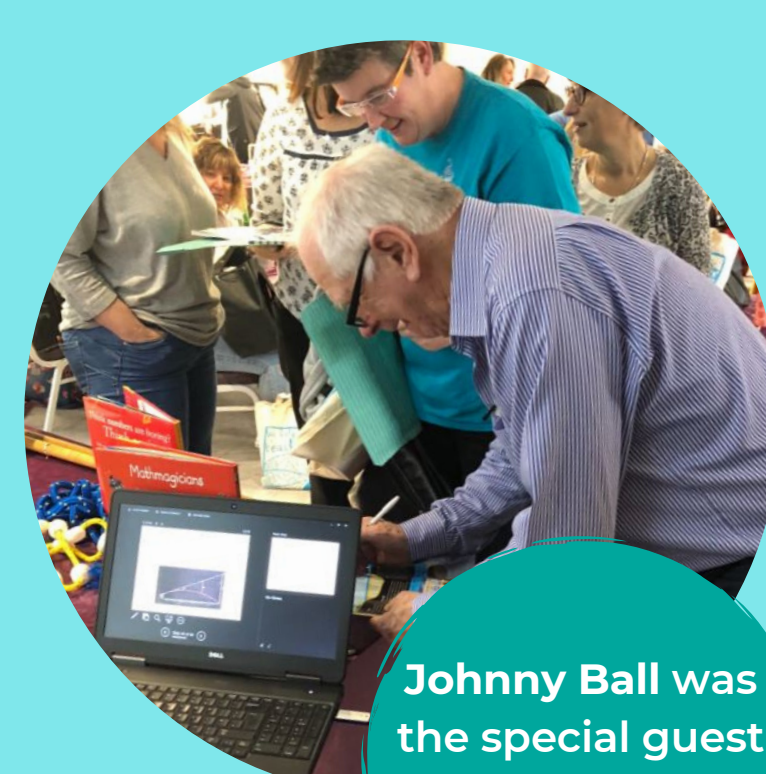
