Nottingham City Council's Adventure Team is COVID Secure and has been recognised as such by the Council for Learning Outside the Classroom's (CLOtC) Quality Badge scheme.

The Government's guidance to schools is that:

"In the autumn term, schools can resume non-overnight domestic educational visits" and that "The curriculum should remain broad, so that the majority of pupils are taught a full range of subjects over the year, including physical education/sport".

"Outdoor sports should be prioritised where possible" and "Schools are able to work with external coaches, clubs and organisations for curricular and extra-curricular activities".

We've really missed seeing schools over the spring and summer terms and know that many young people and staff will have missed out on many beneficial learning and development experiences.

On a positive note we have had a really encouraging August welcoming family groups to participate in a range of COVID Secure Adventurous Activities and providing outreach to summer activity providers. We are very excited to welcome schools back and a number of schools have already worked in partnership with us to book either outreach or Colwick Park Adventure Centre based activity days.
