Safeguarding Training Programme for 2022-23

The Local Authority have released details of their safeguarding training programme for 2022-23. Please find attached a copy of the programme, which lists all training planned over the year along with booking links for each of the sessions.

CPD Offer to all NST schools – The Science of Learning

NST schools are being offered six sessions of CPD based on the science of learning. They will be high quality sessions and useful for schools/staff who want to deepen their understanding of how children learn and strategies that can be used in the classroom to support this.

The six sessions are being offered at a 20% reduced rate. **This equates to a total cost of £184 +VAT per school for 6 one-hour sessions.**

The CPD is currently being offered to schools in Hackney, Tower Hamlet and NST and will be delivered by experienced practitioners.

The sessions are as follows:

Session 1- 11th Oct- Understanding Dual Coding

Session 2- 8th Nov- Making use of cognitive load theory Part 1.

Session 3: 10th Jan 2023- Using Schemas Part 1.

Session 4: 28th Feb 2023- Making use of cognitive load theory Part 2 (Prior Learning)

Session 5: 6th June 2023- Using practice and retrieval

Session 6: 27th June 2023- Using Schemas Part 2

Impact of the RSC Rehearsal Room Pedagogy on Language Development – Training, Research and Teacher Development Opportunity

Please find attached an information sheet and a letter of invitation for this opportunity, which is focussing on Y5 pupils. In a nutshell:

- Up to 60 primary schools across England will take part in a two-year programme in which developed research measures to chart the impact of this pedagogy in the classroom.
- Split into 2 groups of 30 schools each - 1 group will be trained in the first year 2022-23 and observed and the 2nd group will be observed (as a control group) and then trained in 2023-24 and observed for any impact and difference.
- The 5 days of training, accommodation and cover (spread across the year) is all funded and presents schools with a fantastic opportunity to develop amazing teaching and learning in their classrooms.
- Schools have to meet a deprivation criteria of being over 20.8% FSM.
