

Flying High Teaching School Hub Spring 25 Newsletter

Teaching Sequence for Writing

Teresa Heathcote will be partnering with the soon to be launched Literacy Excellence Centre (LEC), and the first programmes she will be running will be:

1. Induction / Repeat sessions for the Teaching Sequence – so new staff in NST schools can be trained in September.

- 2. A new cohort of TSFW if you have any schools that want to go through it in fully.
- 3. Additional sessions on planning for writing (for leaders, teachers and children)

All new sessions will come with a dedicated toolkit to provide better scaffolding and consistency back in school, along with diagnostic tool and guided reviews to trouble shoot and learn together.
