#### Focus4TAPS Three-Day Primary Science CPD Programme

Last call to <u>register interest</u> for the 2025-26 Focus4TAPS **three-day primary science CPD programme**, that has been shown by the EEF to have a <u>positive impact</u> on children's learning.

As a follow on to the latest EEF trial, we are able to offer the course for the **highly subsidised fee of £450 per school** (normally price £850). This includes all three CPD days for **two teachers** per school (the science lead and another teacher who would benefit e.g. science buddy in the opposite key stage or newer teacher looking to develop practice). This subsidised price is for the post-trial 2025-26 year only and is open to all. Schools will not need to provide any pupil data and there are no set year groups required to attend: the CPD is relevant to the whole primary phase.
